2. A personal statement (approximately 100 - 150 words) that explains why the applicant should receive a grant
3. Two letters of reference/recommendation

Each Applicant who submit's the proper documentation by the submittal date will be invited for an interview with the selection committee.

Selections will be made mainly on the basis of need and good academic standing.

Student id Number of winning student(s) will be required before grant can be submitted to institute that student is going to attend.

The recipient of the grant will be notified by June 1, 2022 or soon thereafter.
